All boys should bring smart casual clothes for theatre outings etc (jeans & trainers are not acceptable for these occasions).

SIXTH FORM boys should bring a suit for interviews and special occasions

Important Notes:

- **Parents are advised that all items of clothing should be machine washable and be able to be tumble dried.**
- **All items must be clearly marked with sewn-on name tapes, not iron on.**
- **Games clothes must be prominently labelled on the outside with regulation name tapes.**
- **Insurance – parents are strongly advised to provide their own insurance cover for their children’s clothing and personal effects.**
